MASTER BLEND TURF MIX is excellent for growing grass made up from 70% of master blend topsoil and 30% organic growing media screened to 3/4-inch. This mix allows soil to breathe, yet holds moisture to develop strong drought resistant grass roots.

MASTER BLEND BED MIX is a prescription soil manufactured specifically for high intensity growing areas that require premium performance, high organic matter soil. Till into bed or apply directly onto plant beds. Excellent for planting shrubs, annuals, and perennials. Use what the professionals use.

ORGANIC GROWING MEDIA is black rich composted leaves and yard waste, the most important part of any great soil. This product replaces natural organic matter back into the soil. It reduces erosion, retains moisture, and breaks up clay in hard to work soil. It is best if tilled in 3-6 inches for lawn renovations or planting beds, or applied over newly aerated lawn for top dressing.

FIGHT COMPACTED SOILS & RETAIN MOISTURE

Compacted soils are a major problem in this area. Lack of organics, oxygen and water in the soil are mostly to blame. This imbalance may be corrected with CORE AERATION and TOP DRESSING. Top Dressing is a



process of filling aeration holes with a light layer of Organic Growing Media with a spreader or blown into place with Yard Works Install Division.



By adding these organics back to your soil you will help retain vital moisture needed to germinate seeds and inspire root growth in existing lawns.

Fall is the time to plant new lawns or enhance existing ones. Tall or fine fescues can be planted from Sept. 1st through Oct 15th, in any case, soil samples should be taken in this region. Most soils are acidic. A 6.5PH range is ideal for turf type grasses to thrive. In most cases lime is used to raise the PH to a proper level. You may acquire a soil sample from your local extension office.

Various seeds, fertilizers and lime will be available at all of our retail sites.

How Do I Aerate?

- The soil should be moist, not wet.
- Lawns should be thoroughly watered two days prior to aerating, so tines may penetrate deeper and the plugs fall out of the tines easily.
- If aerating after a prolonged rain fall it is important to wait until the soil has dried a bit so soil will not stick in the hollow tines.
- Thorough watering means: 1 inch of water from irrigation or rain fall.
- Aerate the lawn at least two directions to insure good coverage. Be careful on slopes, as well as around buildings, landscape beds and irrigation lines.

Aeration along with adding Composted Organic Growing Media will do the following:

- Increase soil microorganisms that decompose thatch
- Increases water, nutrient and oxygen movement
- Improve Rooting
- Enhance infiltration of rainfall or irrigation
- Help prevent fertilizer and pesticide run off

COMPLETE "DO IT YOURSELF" LAWN RENOVATIONS

If you continue to have trouble establishing a healthy lawn, whether through drought or disease, you can achieve a healthy lawn yourself with a "COMPLETE LAWN RENOVATION." This process may be easier than maintaining an existing unhealthy lawn. Soil samples are always a good idea. All broad-leaf weeds and undesirable grasses should be eliminated before you begin.



To enrich your existing soil, apply a 2 to 3 inch layer of Organic Growing Media over the entire lawn, then till to a 4 to 6 inch depth.

NOTE: You may use our calculation chart located on our web site or this formula :

Length x Width x Depth then divide by 324 = cubic yards needed



If a Complete re-grade is necessary, use Master Blend Turf Mix. (applied 2 to 3 inches across the entire area) Remember all sub grades must slope away from houses or structures.



Depending on the size of the lawn a tractor with power rake capabilities will give your job a professional look. Yes, we rent this fine piece of equipment. Sod or grass seeds, lime or fertilizers should be applied at this time. With seeded lawns a nice even layer of straw may be applied.



Straw blowers will insure even coverage of straw every time. Bailed straw is available at all locations.

Sod or seedlings require frequent watering to ensure constant surface moisture for up to 30 days. On hot days, in the fall, frequent light watering may be needed. Usually, two full growing seasons is the norm when establishing a mature lawn. Follow a sound maintenance program, and help protect your lawn investment.
